AUDITION REQUIREMENTS: Prepare and memorize 60-90 seconds of a show tune similar in style to A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum or a song from the show that best shows off your vocal qualities and range. Be sure to bring piano/vocal sheet music that is clearly marked for the accompanist. Do not expect the pianist to transpose music. Pianist is provided.

WHERE: Auditions will be held at the Arts United Center at 303 East Main Street. Enter from the rear of the building, using the glass doors to the Green Room. Please arrive 15 minutes early to check in. If you didn't email your audition form and photo to Eunice in advance, bring it with you to give to the stage manager upon arrival.

**CAST OF CHARACTERS:** Must be age 17 or older to audition and we encourage all ethnicities to audition.

**Prologus:** Introduces audience to the comedy they are to see. Same actor portrays Pseudolus in Act 1 & Senex in Act 2 Male, Age: 30-50, Vocal range: A2-A4

**Senex:** An old man and father to Hero and husband to Domina. Male, Age: 45-70, Vocal range: B2-G4 **Domina:** Senex's wife. A shrewish woman who dominates. Female, Age: 40-50, Vocal range: B3-F5

**Hero:** Son of Senex & Domina, falls in love w/ Philia, practical, privileged, romantic. Male, Age: 20-30 Vocal range: B2-G4 **Hysterium:** Chief slave in the House of Senex, believes he is in control, but is actually Pseudolus' puppet to carry out his schemes. Male, Age: 40-55, Vocal range: D4-G5

**Pseudolus:** Roman slave, owned by Hero, seeks to win his freedom. Quick-witted, scheming, childlike spirit. Male, Age: 30-50, Vocal range: A2-A4

Erronius: An old man, searching for his lost children. Male, Age: 45-70, Vocal range: B2-G4

**Miles Gloriosus:** Roman army captain to whom Marcus Lycus has promised Philia. Commanding, boastful, manly and strong. Male, Age: 25-35, Vocal range: B3-F5

Lycus: Owner of the house of Courtesans. Always out to make a profit. Male, Age: 40-50, Vocal range: A3-F5

**Philia:** A virgin in the House of Lycus. She is promised to Miles but loves Hero. Young, pretty, devoted. An archetypal

ingénue. Female, Age: 18-21, Vocal range: B3-G5

Ensemble: Courtesans, Proteans, Soldiers
